A rational number is a number that is expressed in the form of p/q, where 'p' and 'q' are integers and q ≠ 0. In other words, a rational number is simply a fraction where the integer a is the numerator, and integer b is the denominator. Example of rational numbers include: 2/3, 5/8, -3/14, -11/-5, 7/-9, 7/-15 and -6/-11 etc.

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Rational Equations. A rational equation is an equation that contains fractions with xs in the numerator, denominator or both.Here is an example of a rational equation: $(4 / (x + 1)) - (3 / (x - 1) ...$
