12 LABORATORY SAMPLE PREPARATION

It should be applied in liberal quantities and remain in contact with excreta for at least 2 hr. Calcium hydroxide is now used in place of calcium oxide in prepn of lime water. Lime soaps formed by reaction of calcium hydroxide with vegetable oils are adhesive and are sometimes used as ointment base (lime liniment or "carron oil").
