Your Grade Level Assessment Expectations identifies the grade level expository passage to use as a starting place for assessment in the fall (if the student's Word List indicates a starting place on grade level). For example, the grade four passage for the fall is Early Railroads; grade five is The Octopus. If the child is not on grade level, you will choose an expository passage from the prior grade's list of passages.
