Students can be eligible for free or reduced lunch based on family income — the cutoffs are determined based on the federal poverty level (at 130 percent of poverty level for free meals and 185 percent for reduced-price meals). These income levels vary by family size, but they can be viewed in this chart from the Government Publishing Office.

Meal Eligibility

INDIANA, (WOWO) – The Indiana Department of Education has announced the new income eligibility guidelines for free and reduced-price school lunches. The National School Lunch, School Breakfast and Special Milk

Children need healthy meals to learn. If your school participates in the National School Lunch Program, your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. This packet includes an application for free or reduced price meal benefits, and a set of detailed instructions.

Apply - Free and Reduced Lunch

The guidelines establish that students in a household of four, with income of \$33,475 per year or less, qualify for free school meals. If that family's yearly income is between \$33,475.01 and \$47,638, children can receive reduced-price meals.

Income eligibility guidelines announced for school and day ...

Children from families whose total household income is within the reduced price limits on the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines Chart can get school meals at a maximum reduced price of 30 cents for breakfast and 40 cents for lunch.

NC DPI: Eligibility Requirements Set for School Lunch Program

Your child can receive low-cost meals if your household income is within the reduced price limits on the Eligibility Guidelines. Please complete an application. I receive WIC (Women, Infants, and Children) benefits. Can my child get free meals? Children in households participating in WIC may be eligible for reduced price or free meals.

Food & Nutrition / Free and Reduced Meal Applications

In all other schools, household size and income will be used to determine eligibility for free or reduced-price meal benefits. Children from households whose income is at or below the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines, shown in the chart below, may be eligible for either free or reduced-price meals.
